After an Energy Audit is completed, you may be eligible to receive one or more of the following:

- ▶ Insulation
- Caulking and Weather stripping
- ▶ Compact Fluorescent Lighting
- ▶ Refrigerator Replacement
- ▶ Heating System Repair, Retrofit, or Replacement
- ▶ Hot Water Heater Repair or Replacement
- ▶ Window and/or Door Repair or Replacement
