

The Borough of Bogota recently completed more than \$79,000 in energy efficiency upgrades through the PSE&G Direct Install Program. PSE&G paid for 70% of the improvements up front, and the municipality will repay 30% of the cost, interest-free, over the next three years.

The work will save the Borough of Old Tappan over \$6,000 a year in energy costs. The energy savings will allow the municipality to reinvest the savings to community improvements or other parts of their budget.





Work included energy efficient LED lighting and mechanical upgrades in both the interior and exterior of the Municipal Building, Recreation Center, Fire Houses, and Rescue Squad that totaled savings of more than 33,000 kWh a year, which is a 47% reduction in their energy usage.
