

Important information about summer shut-offs

If you are having trouble paying your energy bills this summer, the NJ Board of Public Utilities (BPU) has a program to protect you from having your electricity, water and/or wastewater turned off from June 15 through August 31.

Who is eligible?

You qualify for protection during this period if you are being helped by one of the programs listed below:

- The Federal Home Energy Assistance Program (HEAP)
- The Universal Service Fund (USF)
- The Lifeline Credit Program
- Temporary Assistance for Needy Families (TANF)
- Federal Supplemental Security Income (SSI)
- General Assistance Benefits (GA)
- Pharmaceutical Assistance to the Aged and Disabled (PAAD); or
- If you are an applicant of any state, local, or utility program that provides assistance or discounted rates specifically to help eligible customers pay wastewater or water bills; or
- If you cannot pay because of problems beyond your control.

What do you have to do?

If you qualify for protection (see section above, "Who is eligible?") from shut-off during this period, you **must** call PSE&G and set up a Summer Payment Plan. The toll-free telephone number is 1-800-357-2262. As part of this plan, you must pay as much as you can on your PSE&G bill during the summer. By staying on your Summer Payment Plan, your electric bills will be easier to pay. If you and PSE&G cannot agree on a payment plan, PSE&G will ask the BPU to make a plan for you. - **The Universal Service Fund (USF) Program***
Year-round help for residents of New Jersey. If you are enrolled in USF and have a balance of \$60 or greater, you will also be included in the Fresh Start program that provides forgiveness of past-due balances every five years.
