¿Quién es elegible?

Si se usó esta técnica de dificultades para pagar las facturas de energía eléctrica en invierno, la Junta de Servicios Públicos de NJ BPPU, con siglas en inglés (N.J. Public Service Commission), estableció un programa para proteger a los hogares de aguas residuales entre el 15 de noviembre y el 15 de marzo. Este periodo puede ser extendido si las condiciones lo requieren. La Junta de Servicios Públicos de NJ mantiene una lista de proveedores de servicios de energía eléctrica que ofrecen programas de ayuda para pagar las facturas de energía eléctrica.

If you are having trouble paying your energy bills this winter, the NJ Board of Public Utilities (BPU) has a program to protect you from having your gas, electricity, water and/or wastewater turned off from November 15 through March 15. This period may be extended beyond March 15 if winter conditions continue.

Who is eligible?

You qualify for protection during this period if you are being helped by one of the programs listed below:

- The Low Income Home Energy Assistance Program (LIHEAP)
 - The Universal Service Fund (USF)
 - NJ Lifeline Credit Program
 - Temporary Assistance for Needy Families (TANF)
 - Supplemental Security Income (SSI)
 - Work First New Jersey General Assistance (GA)
 - Pharmaceutical Assistance to the Aged and Disabled (PAAD);
or
 - If you cannot pay because of problems beyond your control.

What do you have to do?

If you qualify for protection (see section above, "Who is eligible?") from shut-off during this period, you **must** call PSE&G and set up a Winter Payment Plan. The toll-free telephone number is 1-800-357-2262. As part of this plan, you must pay as much as you can on your PSE&G bill during the winter. By staying on your Winter Payment Plan, your electric and gas bills will be easier to pay. If you and PSE&G cannot agree on a payment plan, PSE&G will ask the BPU to make a plan for you. You can also call the BPU at 1-800-624-0241 with any questions.
