## To ensure that your heating system is working properly:

- · have your heating system checked annually
- keep the area surrounding the heating system free of combustible items including boxes, paper, clothing, paint and other flammables
- · keep vents clear

- your heating equipment was exposed to floodwater

A boiler or furnace can overheat when a heating unit reaches an exceedingly high temperature and pressure and will not shut off. This condition is caused by failure of safety controls and can result in an explosion or fire.

## Your system may be overheating if it:

- will not shut off
- is leaking water or steam
- is a cherry red color
  - has paint peeling off at the
- has temperature or pressure gauges
  at the highest levels
