** For family units of more than 8 members, add \$8,840 for each member.*

To apply, you must:

- ▶ Meet the annual income guidelines above
- ▶ Be a renter or homeowner
- ▶ Not have received this weatherization service September 30, 1994

What types of services are included?

After an Energy Audit is completed, you may be eligible to receive one or more of the following:

- ▶ Insulation
- ▶ Caulking and Weather stripping
- ▶ Compact Fluorescent Lighting
- ▶ Refrigerator Replacement
- ▶ Heating System Repair, Retrofit, or Replacement
- ▶ Hot Water Heater Repair or Replacement
- ▶ Window and/or Door Repair or Replacement
